A little bit about our home

9 Castlereagh Street

Designed by Architect Harry Seidler, our Sydney office known as the Capita Centre comprises a 600ft tall 34 level A-Grade tower with a prime position in the heart of the Sydney CBD.

Home to several corporate offices, Capita Centre boasts a striking landmark tower with column-free design and contemporary office spaces. With an open plan space, the Vinarchy office on level 10 features modern atrium and garden views. Shortly after completion in 1989, the building won the Royal Australian Institute of Architects (NSW) merit award 1991 and the Australian Institute of Architects (NSW) Commercial Architect Commendation award in 2012, following a building refurbishment the previous year.

Capita Centre is located on the western side of Castlereagh Street between Hunter Street and Market Place and offers quick access to nearby transport hotspots including Wynyard, Circular Quay and Martin Place stations.



First opened in 1989, Capita Centre features a unique design aesthetic, wearing its support structures as an external feature and a diagonal light shaft running directly through the centre of the building.



Short distances to various shopping precincts including Westfield Sydney, the Queen Victoria Building and The Galleries.



The Capita Centre is conveniently located next to a range of health, recreation, food and childcare facilities. For a bite to eat or a quick coffee break, you can also head straight downstairs to Reaghs Caffe & Bar in the buzzing lobby area.





Getting here

Our office is centrally located around the corner from Martin Place in the Sydney CBD. It is well serviced by public transport being close to bus stops, train stations, and a short walk from ferry and tram stations. There are a number of transport options available for you to reach the office.



The majority of Sydney's bus network make use of Elizabeth Street or the Queen Victoria Building. Both are close to the office!

The compact nature of the City means it is very walkable.



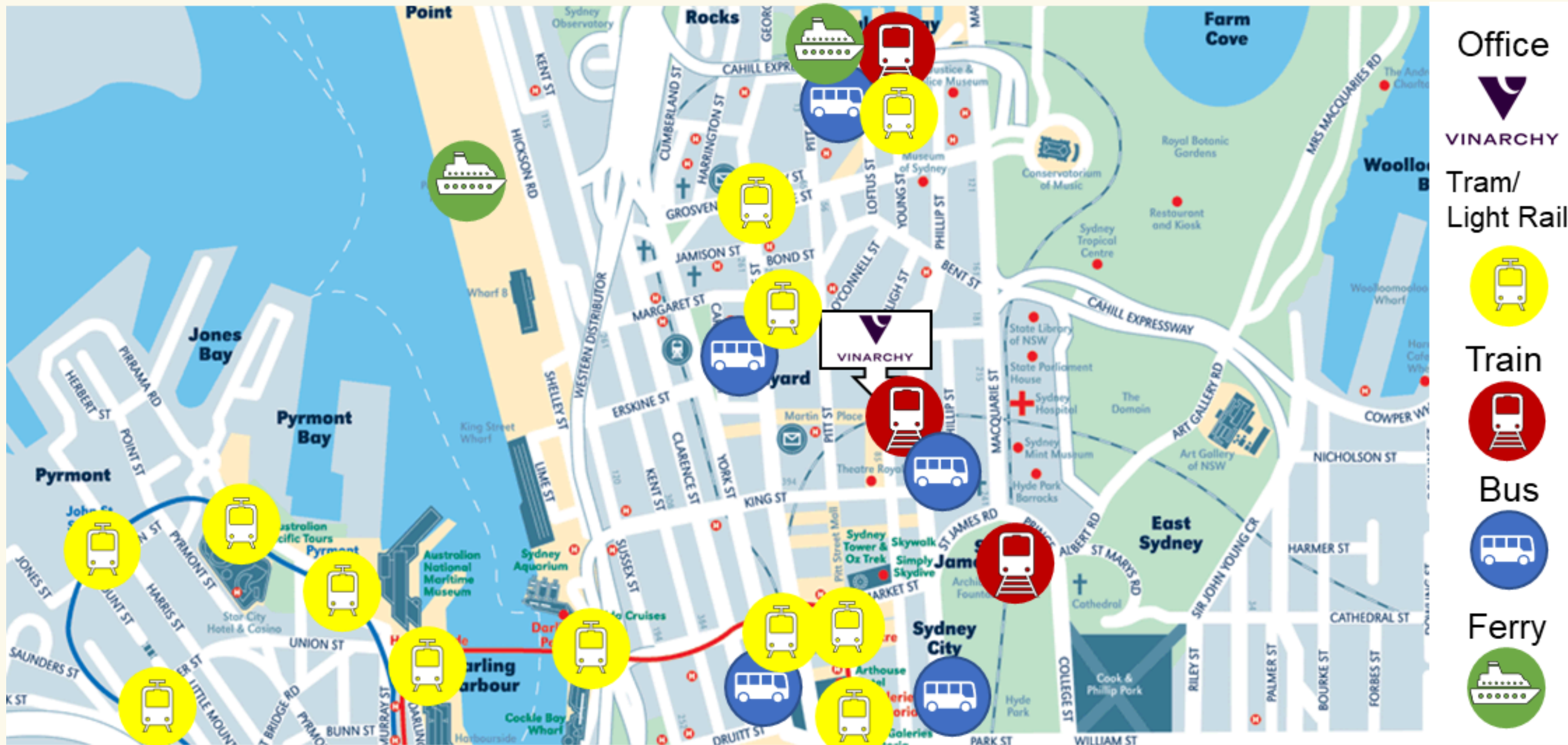
Our office contains end of trip facilities so cycling could be a good option. Speak to Concierge for more information

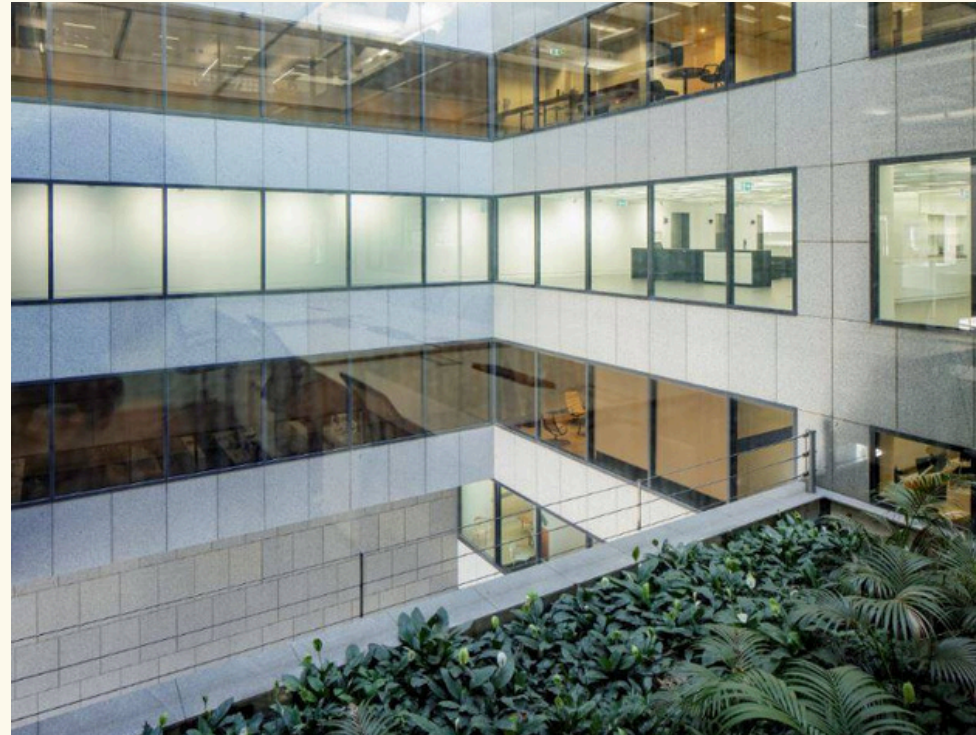
